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## **2016-17 GENESEE VALLEY CSD BOARD OF EDUCATION GOALS**

1. Communications
  - a. During the 2016-17 school year, the district will research and install a new website platform and improve communication with and amongst all stakeholders by June 30, 2017. The district will continue to support the use of School Messenger, Power School, GVCS APP and the increased use of Facebook, Twitter and the district webpage to improve communication.
2. Community Access / Education
  - a. During the 2016-17 school year, the district will create and fill the position of a Social Worker / Home / School Liaison. This person shall include stakeholder meetings to discuss the district's mission, vision, values, instructional priorities and relationship between district and the community.
3. Promoting STEAM learning
  - a. During the 2016-17 school year, the district will promote the innovation of practice and new partnerships to enhance and encourage the development of a PK-12 STEAM initiative at Genesee Valley CSD. This shall include the promotion of Project-Based Instruction, development of cross-curricular, interdisciplinary activities that incorporate Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math and the continued promotion of rigorous college credit bearing electives, CLEP and Advanced Placement courses.
4. Financial Goals
  - a. During the 2016-17 school year, the district will redefine and implement a capital building project that addresses the issues identified by the Building Condition Survey prior to June 30, 2017. The district will also develop a Capital Outlay Project to implement during the Summer of 2017. The district will engage all stakeholders and incorporate community feedback.
5. Leadership Goals
  - a. During the 2016-17 school year, the district will implement a Future Leaders Initiative at Genesee Valley Central School District by June 30, 2017. This program will continue the work of the prior year to encourage and support aspiring school leaders and teachers to gain the necessary training and certification to become the next leaders of the district.
